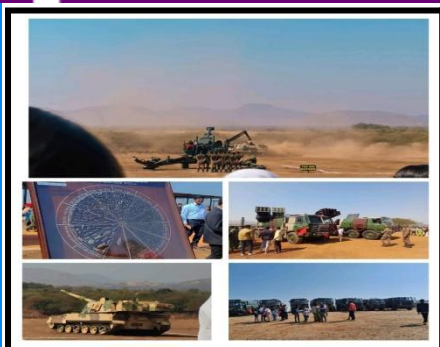

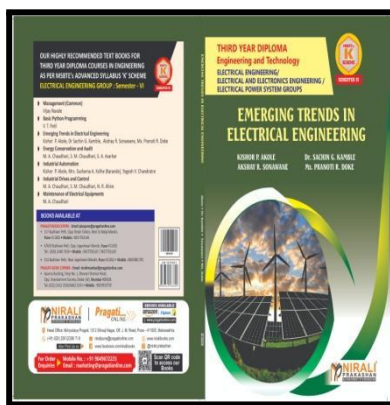
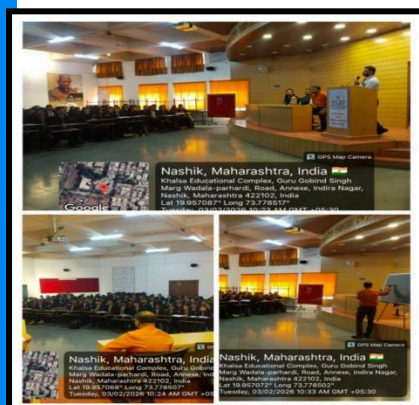

RECENT TRENDS IN ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SOURCE (SOLAR ENERGY)

As of early 2026, India's solar energy sector is experiencing a rapid surge, with the country achieving a historic 100 gigawatts (GW) of PV module manufacturing capacity and ranking third globally in solar energy. Driven by the "Make in India" initiative and the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme, manufacturing capacity is booming, with major investments from firms like Adani and Reliance focusing on integrated solar manufacturing. Key projects such as the 550,000-acre Reliance Kutch project and the PM-KUSUM scheme continue to bolster large-scale and rural solar deployment to meet the ambitious goal of 500 GW non-fossil capacities by 2030. Despite this growth, the industry faces challenges, including a preliminary 126% duty imposed by the US on Indian solar exports and the need for a stable domestic raw material supply chain.
