

Instructions and Guidelines to Submit a Paper through EasyChair

Abstract and Paper Submission

The submission and review of papers for **IC-RTETM-22** will be managed *through EasyChair*; an online conference paper management system.

This guide was prepared to support authors during the submission process that consists of four stages:

1. Abstract submission
2. Draft paper submission
3. Revised paper submission
4. Final paper submission


I. SET UP AN ACCOUNT

1. First, you will need an **EasyChair Account** (username and password) as an author to submit your abstract /paper.

Go to: <https://easychair.org/account/signup>

If you already have an EasyChair account from another conference, you can use that account to submit a paper to **RTETM-22**.

Follow the provided instructions to verify and then click on “Continue” as Shown in Figure 1.

6. Updating information

- After completing a submission, a new menu bar ("Submission #" or "MySubmissions" in the case of multiple submissions) is created (as shown in Figure 10). Click on “Submission #” for changing any information about the submission.
- Use the links at the top-right corner (update information, update authors, withdraw) if you want to update any information about the submission and authors or withdraw the submission.
 - a. **Updating information about your submission:** select “Update information” from the right-hand menu of the Submission screen to change any of title, abstract and keywords of your submission.
 - b. **Updating author information for your submission:** select “Up-date authors” to modify any information about the author(s) and click “save”. In the case of multiple authors, you can add (“Add new author”) or remove authors (Click on “X”); then update the order of the authors by selecting the “Reorder authors” button.
 - c. **Uploading files:** the “Add file” link may be used to upload files.
 - d. **Withdrawing the submission:** select “Withdraw” to withdraw the submission.

III.SUBMIT FULL PAPERS

1. The Scientific Committee will review all abstracts and notify the results and paper ID to authors.
2. The authors of accepted abstracts will be invited to submit full papers.
3. Please use the paper template provided on our conference website.
4. Use the links at the top-right corner, (update information, update authors, add file, and withdraw) as shown in Figure 10, if you want to update any information about the submission, authors, submit or withdraw the submission.
5. Submit a full paper by selecting “Add file”. You will be able to select the file you want to upload with the link “Choose file”.
6. Please bear in mind that only PDF files are supported in peer review process. Information of authors should not be presented in submission to reviewers.
7. Once you have uploaded a paper, you may change the file by selecting “Update file” from the right hand menu of this screen.

8. Please note that you are unable to update the file after the full paper submission deadline.

9. The system will send an email to confirm your submission. Once the full paper review process is completed, you will receive acceptance/rejection notification with reviews by email.
10. Authors should double check the originality of your text with plagiarism check before submitting full paper to **IC-RTETM-22** conference. Such website as, [1Text.com](https://www.iText.com) or [Turnitin](https://www.turnitin.com) could be helpful.

IV. SUBMIT YOUR REVISED PAPERS

1. If your full paper is accepted, we will ask you to submit your 1st revised paper. Please revise your paper considering all the reviewers' comments and modify the manuscript accordingly.
2. To upload the revised paper, click on "Submission #" and select "Update file" from the right-hand menu of the Submission screen.
3. We might ask authors to submit your 2nd revised paper electronically if the publisher has further requirements, mostly about technical issues or format of the paper.
